

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Commissioners Court of Shelby County, Texas will hold a public hearing to receive comments and/or questions from the public regarding its pending budget for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, at 9:30 AM in the County Courtroom located in the Shelby County Courthouse at 200 San Augustine St, Center TX 75935. The proposed budget is on file in the County Clerk's Office and may be viewed Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. or online <https://www.co.shelby.tx.us/page/shelby.Budgets>.

**This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$873,632, which is an 8.13 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$164,217.00.**

Items to be considered included a possible increase in salary to elected county and precinct officers as follows: Commissioners, Sheriff, District Clerk, County Clerk, Tax Assessor/Collector, County Treasurer, County Judge, Constables Precincts 1-5, County Attorney, Justices of the Peace 1-5, and County Auditor; proposed increase \$2600 each. For the 123<sup>rd</sup> and 273<sup>rd</sup> District Judges, the proposed increase is \$3000 each.
